1. eClaims® & SimDay® Minimum System Requirements

Terminal Servers (TS) :	ACSS applications can be installed and configured in a TS environment using Remote Desktop or Thin Point. The TS environment can be either in a LAN or WAN.
Wide Area Network (WAN) :	For WAN, we strongly recommend high Internet speeds. ACSS only recommends eClaims® or SimDay® use via Remote Desktop when in a WAN environment. To improve performance, colour schemes within eClaims®\SimDay® can be reduced.
Apple MAC :	eClaims® and SimDay® are both Windows only applications. However on the new Apple's, there is a Windows emulator, which allows Windows based

applications to run.

2. Application Information

The following features apply to both eClaims® and SimDay®:

- Designed in Visual FoxPro
- Uses a Visual FoxPro database
- No SQL or mySQL licenses required
- Application and Data resides on the Server
- Basic DLL and registery files need to be install on the client workstations

3. Network Permission Requirements

3.1 Requirements for Installing eClaims® or SimDay® (LAN)

Server

- Full administrator rights
- Ability to share the eClaims® or SimDay® folder with read/write permissions to allow clients to access data from other workstations
- Ability to install Java V1.5.0
- Ability to add / modify environment variables

Workstations

- Full administrator rights
- Ability to give users read/write permissions to allow clients to access data
- Ability to install Java V1.5.0
- Ability to add / modify environment variables

3.2 Requirements for Running eClaims® or SimDay® (LAN)

Server and Workstations

- Ability to read/write to the local eClaims® (or SimDay®) folder and sub folders

(e.g. c:\eclmpluswin or c:\SimDay)

- Java needs to be Installed
- Ability to modify system environment variables (usually for proxy changes or other program updates)
- Ability to access Medicare website (https://www2.medicareaustralia.gov.au/pext)
- HTTP and FTP access to the ACSS website for automatic updates (www.acsshealth.com)

Workstations Only

- Ability to read/write to the server eClaims® (or SimDay®) folder and sub folders

(e.g. \\server\eclmpluswin or \\server\simday)

- Access to the server PC uninterrupted for file share purposes

3.3 Requirements for Running eClaims® or SimDay® (WAN)

Server and Workstations

- eClaims® and SimDay® will run adequately via a WAN but only when using it thought Terminal Services (Remote Desktop).
- eClaims® and SimDay® will not work efficiently using LAN settings over a WAN.

3.4 Remote Access

- Allowing ACSS remote access to the eClaims® or SimDay® server allows for much easier support
